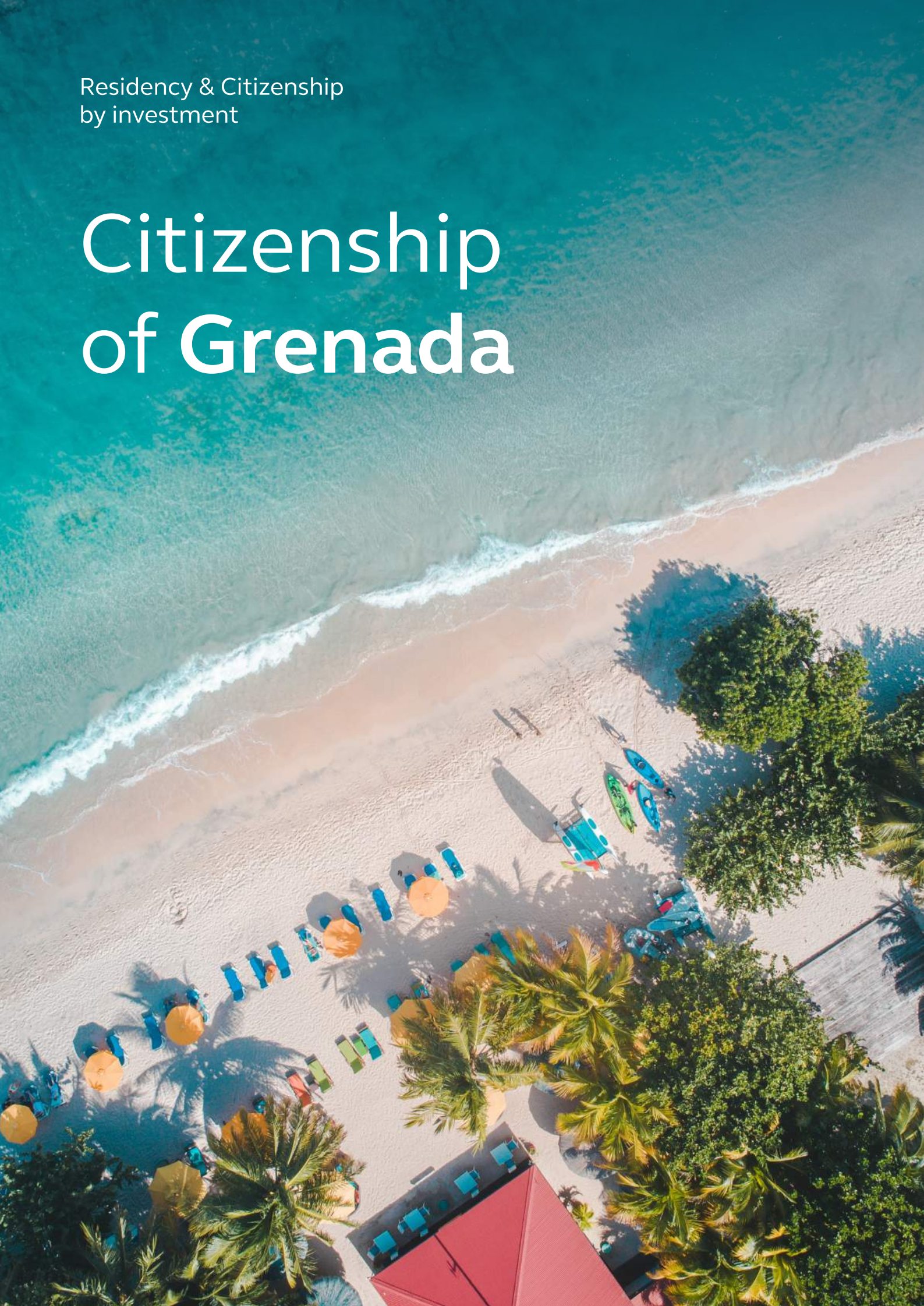

Citizenship of Grenada

The Grenada Citizenship Program is the fastest and most economical way of acquiring a second passport. Investors can choose from two options:

- | either to make a donation in favour of the State of a minimum of \$150,000;
- | or invest in real estate worth a minimum of \$ 220,000.

An important advantage of Grenadian citizenship is that Grenada is the only Caribbean country that has in place an E-2 investor Visa Treaty with the US, which enables Grenadians to work and reside in the US without any restrictions. While applying for the program all family members can be included in one application including spouse, dependent children, parents, grandparents and unmarried siblings.



Favourable tax policy

No taxes on worldwide income, heritage or capital growth

Investment Options

In March 2024, Grenada announced the minimum investment for this program **will increase to at least \$200,000 «no later than 30 June 2024»**. Applications submitted before the price increase will keep the current investment requirements.

Donation to the State

- | A non-refundable contribution is made to the National Transformation fund (NTF).
- | The contribution may vary depending on the number of family members under one application.

Investment in real estate

- | All real estate projects must be approved by the government.
- | Investors can sell the property after a 5-year period, freeing up the capital without jeopardizing the citizenship.

The minimum required investment in publicly approved real estate in tourist housing. This would be for shared ownership.

Investors can also purchase real estate on the secondary market, providing it has been approved by the government. Thus, program participants can sell real estate to another citizenship candidate, who in turn will be eligible for a Grenada passport.

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Visa-Free Travel to 144 Countries Worldwide, including the EU, the UK and China

Citizenship of Grenada offers visa-free travel across the world without visa applications or restrictions. Enjoy total freedom of movement with a Grenadian passport which allows you to travel visa-free to many countries worldwide including the EU, the UK and China. The lack of restrictions offers complete freedom to arrange business trips at any time with no prior planning, or a spontaneous family vacation in Europe, giving total flexibility.

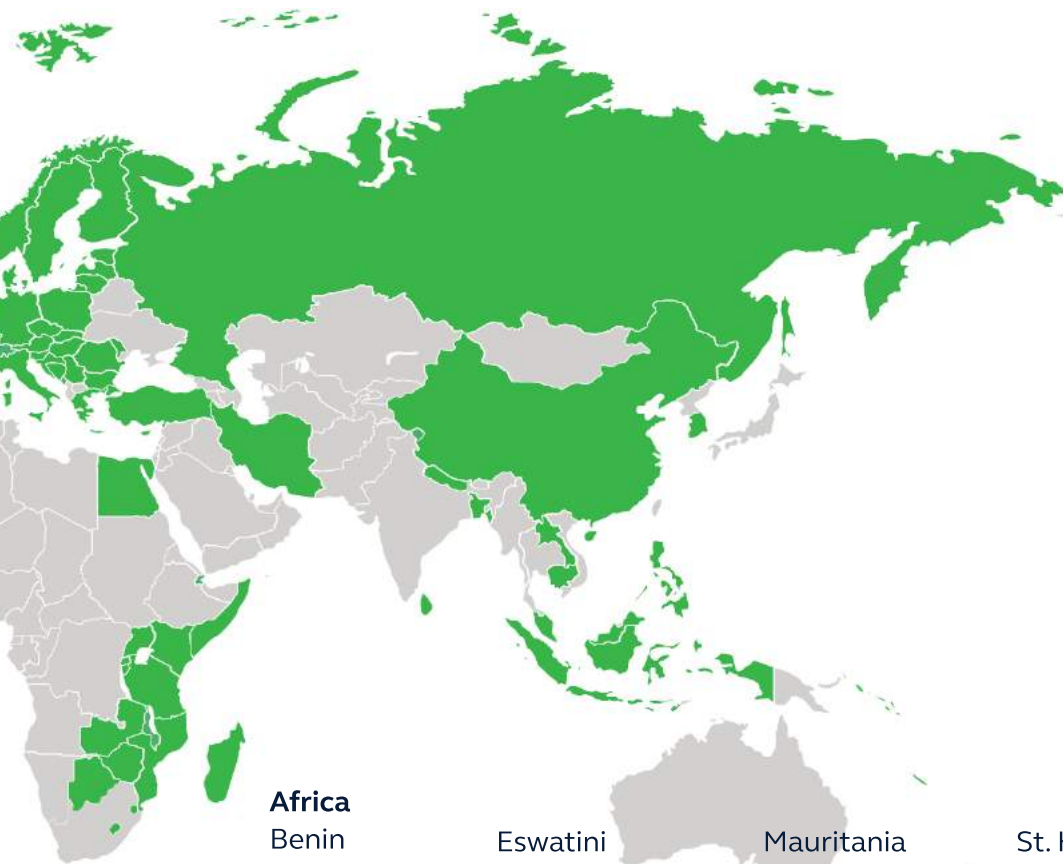

Eligibility For Grenada Citizenship By Investment

The applicant’s entire family can be included under one application. The main applicant must be 18 years old or over, and must not have a criminal record.

The application can include:

- | spouse
- | the main applicant’s siblings their spouse’s siblings, unmarried and with no children
- | parents and grandparents of any age, who must be financially dependent or at least have no income of their own
- | children including financially dependent children under 30 years old; children of 18-30 years old are no longer required to be enrolled in a higher educational institution

Once your application is approved you are required to carry out the investment.
